

## Sunday Teaching on Spiritual Laws & Harvesting Miracles 8/31/25

- 1) Do you know the ordinances of the heavens? Can you set their dominion over the earth? Job 38:33
- 2) The Lord has established His throne in heaven, and **His kingdom rules** over all. Psalm 103:19
- 3) And He said to them, “To you **it has been given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God**; but to those who are outside, all things come in parables, Mark 4:11
- 4) But seek the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added to you. Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father’s good pleasure to **give you the kingdom**. Luke 12:31-32
- 5) Listen, my beloved brethren: Has God not chosen the poor of this world to be rich in faith and **heirs of the kingdom** which He promised to those who love Him? James 2:5
- 6) “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to **preach the gospel to the poor**; Luke 4:18
- 7) Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the **gospel of the kingdom of God**, and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.” Mark 1:14-15
- 8) My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips. **Once I have sworn by My holiness; I will not lie to David..** Psalm 89:34-35
- 9) The sower **sows the word**. And these are the ones by the wayside where the word is sown. When they hear, Satan comes immediately and takes away the word that was **sown in their hearts**. Mark 4:14-15
- 10) And He said, “The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground, and should sleep by night and rise by day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he himself does not know how. For the earth yields crops by itself: first the blade, then the head, after that the full grain in the head. But when the grain ripens, **immediately he puts in the sickle**, because the harvest has come.” Mark 4:26-29
- 11) For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, (**are justified-justice**) and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Romans 10:10 NKJV
- 12) By believing you **receive God's approval**, and by declaring your faith you are saved. Romans 10:10 GWT
- 13) Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, **He hears us**. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that **we have the petitions** that we have asked of Him. 1 John 5:14-15
- 14) So Jesus answered and said to them, “Have faith in God. For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, **he will have whatever he says**. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.” Mark 11:22-4

15) Then David spoke to the men who stood by him, saying, “What shall be done for the man who kills this Philistine and takes away the reproach from Israel? For **who is this uncircumcised Philistine**, that he should defy the armies of the living God?” 1 Samuel 17:26

16) But David said to Saul, “Your servant used to keep his father’s sheep, and when **a lion or a bear** came and took a lamb out of the flock, I went out after it and struck it, and delivered the lamb from its mouth; and when it arose against me, I caught it by its beard, and struck and killed it. Your servant has killed both lion and bear; and this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, seeing he has defied the armies of the living God.” Moreover, David said, “The Lord, who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, He will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine.” 1 Samuel 17:34-37

17) Then he took his staff in his hand; and he chose for himself five smooth stones from the brook, and put them in a shepherd’s bag, in a pouch which he had, and his sling was in his hand. And he drew near to the Philistine. 1 Samuel 17:40

18) And when the Philistine looked about and saw David, he disdained him; for he was only a youth, ruddy and good-looking. So the Philistine said to David, “Am I a dog, that you come to me with sticks?” And the Philistine cursed David by his gods. And the Philistine said to David, “Come to me, and I will give your flesh to the birds of the air and the beasts of the field!” 1 Samuel 17:42-44

19) Then David said to the Philistine, “You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. This day **the Lord will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you and take your head from you**. And this day I will give the carcasses of the camp of the Philistines to the birds of the air and the wild beasts of the earth, that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel. Then all this assembly shall know that the Lord does not save with sword and spear; for the battle is the Lord’s, and **He will give you into our hands**.” 1 Samuel 17:45-47

PERSUADED FAITH IN HEART (ROMANS 4-A PROCESS) = JUSTIFICATION/JUSTICE FOLLOWED BY A SICKLE, = MIRACLE, SICKLE IS DEAL CLOSER, SINGLE DECLARATION, HARVEST, SIMPLE WORDS, BASED ON THE FAITH IN THE HEART, SALVATION, SOUZO, MIRACLE TRANSPIRES, MARK 11, ROMANS 4, ROMANS 10, JUSTICE RELEASED.

FAITH IN HEART + SICKLE = ANSWER. (DIVINE MYSTERY) (meditate over and over using verses shared) Abraham, David, Mary, and Jesus and others used this spiritual law.
